

1. **Intro:** What is the state of your soul?
2. **Read Daniel 3:1-7.** Ken argued that all of us are tempted to bow down to the “statue,” the false god of “me.” How do you see that to be true in your own life?
3. **Read Daniel 3:8-12.** Why do you think Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego did not bow to the statue?
4. **Read Daniel 3:13-18.** God is able, but if He doesn’t, He is worthy of worship. In what area of your life do you most need to hear and apply that biblical truth?
5. **Read Daniel 3:19-25.** Sometimes God delivers us from the furnace, but other times God delivers us in the furnace. How might God be trying to meet you in the furnace right now?
6. **Read Daniel 3:26-30.** What is possible when the unbelieving world sees us trusting God in the furnace? Who is watching you, and what are they seeing?

QUESTIONS FOR KIDS

1. Is there anything that is worrying or troubling you right now? Talk about it with your family.
2. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego knew that God was able to save them. What does “God is able” mean to you?
3. Does thinking about who God is make your worries seem smaller? What about the truth that God never abandons us or leaves us alone?
